Kenneth (Ken) Gerspach passed away on September 4 in Buffalo, New York at the age of 86 after a valiant battle with cancer. Ken was born in Buffalo on September 20, 1935 to Valentine and Julia Gerspach. He is survived by his son, Kenneth (Ken/Kenny) M.
